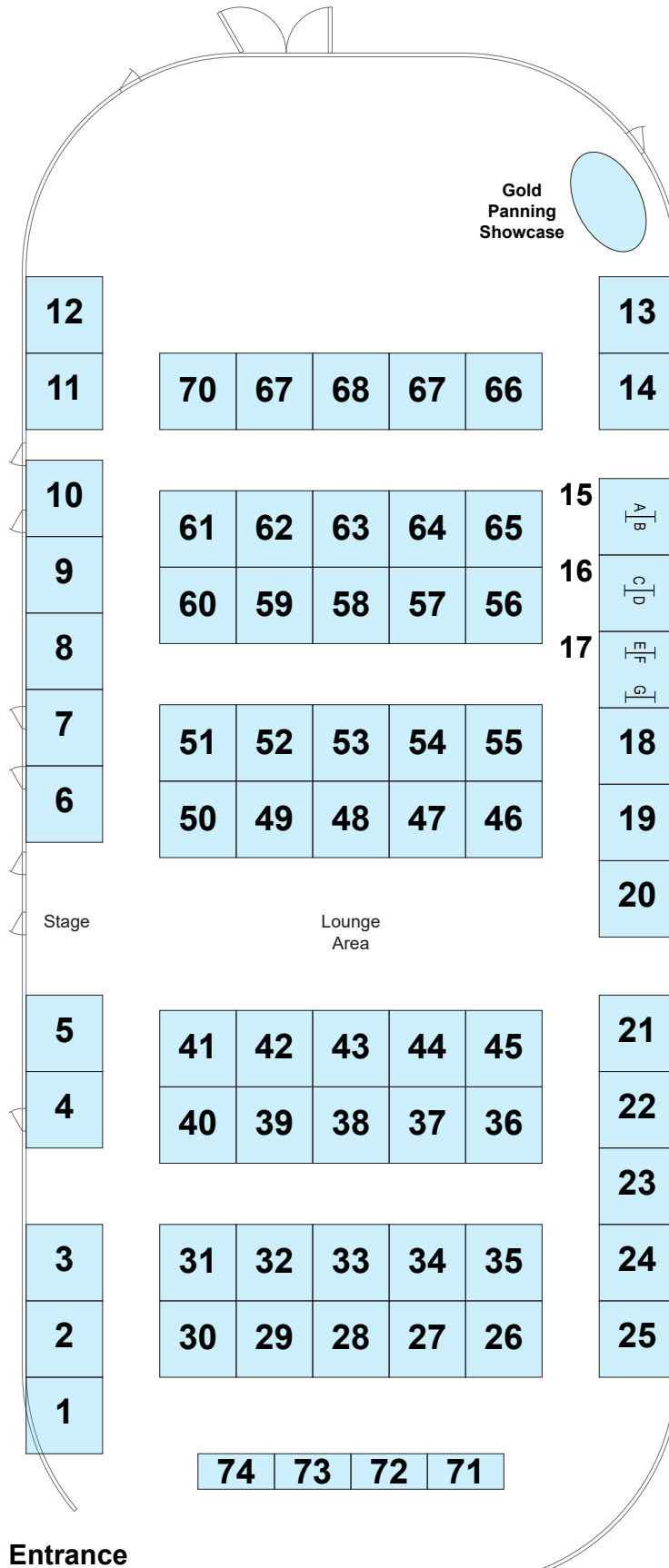

**Clyde Drew is a Mi'kmaq artist** originally from the town of Conne River and currently resides in St. Alban's, Newfoundland and Labrador. His hauntingly intricate three-dimensional art captures the Mi'kmaq culture, tradition and history. A self-taught carver, Clyde began working with wood, chain saw and chisel in his mid 30s, before switching to moose, caribou antlers and whalebone.
